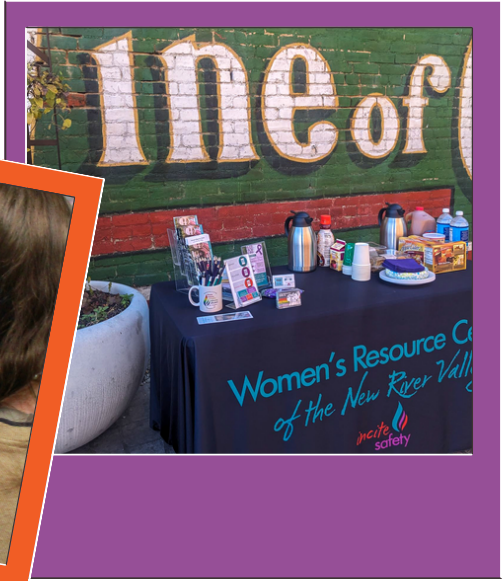
# This year, our clients said:
